Chapter 1369, Insurance Code, is amended by adding Subchapter I to read as follows: 6 7 SUBCHAPTER I. PHARMACY BENEFIT CLAIM ADJUDICATION Sec. 1369.401. DEFINITION. In this subchapter, "pharmacy 8 benefit manager" has the meaning assigned by Section 4151.151. 9 10 Sec. 1369.402. CERTAIN FEES PROHIBITED. A health benefit plan issuer or a pharmacy benefit manager may not directly or 11 indirectly charge or hold a pharmacist or pharmacy responsible for 12 a fee for any step of or component or mechanism related to the claim 13 adjudication process, including: 14 15 (1) the adjudication of a pharmacy benefit claim; 16 (2) the processing or transmission of a pharmacy 17 benefit claim; (3) the development or management of a claim 18 processing or adjudication network; or 19 20 (4) participation in a claim processing or 21 adjudication network. SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act does not 22 affect the terms of a contract, if any, entered into or renewed 23 before the effective date of this Act until a renewal of the 24

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contract that occurs on or after the effective date of this Act.
SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
