(3) going to or near:

2 (A) the residence, place of employment, or
3 business of a member of the family or household or of the person
4 protected under the order; or

5 (B) the residence, child care facility, or school6 where a child protected under the order resides or attends; or

7 (4) possessing a firearm, unless the person is a peace
8 officer, as defined by Section 1.07, Penal Code, actively engaged
9 in employment as a sworn, full-time paid employee of a state agency
10 or political subdivision.

SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
