S.B. No. 114

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT
2 relating to the applicability of adverse licensing, listing, or
3 registration decisions by certain health and human services
4 agencies.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

6 SECTION 1. Section 531.951(a), Government Code, is amended
7 to read as follows:

8 (a) This subchapter applies only to the final licensing,
9 listing, or registration decisions of a health and human services
10 agency with respect to a person under the law authorizing the agency
11 to regulate the following types of persons:

12 (1) a youth camp licensed under Chapter 141, Health
13 and Safety Code;

14 (2) a home and community support services agency
15 licensed under Chapter 142, Health and Safety Code;

16 (3) a hospital licensed under Chapter 241, Health and
17 Safety Code;

18 (4) an institution licensed under Chapter 242, Health
19 and Safety Code;

20 (4-a) an ambulatory surgical center licensed under
21 Chapter 243, Health and Safety Code;

22 (4-b) a birthing center licensed under Chapter 244,
23 Health and Safety Code;

24 (4-c) an abortion facility licensed under Chapter 245,

1 Health and Safety Code;

2 (5) an assisted living facility licensed under Chapter
3 247, Health and Safety Code;

4 (6) a special care facility licensed under Chapter
5 248, Health and Safety Code;

6 (6-a) an end stage renal disease facility licensed
7 under Chapter 251, Health and Safety Code;

8 (7) an intermediate care facility licensed under
9 Chapter 252, Health and Safety Code;

10 (7-a) a freestanding emergency medical care facility
11 licensed under Chapter 254, Health and Safety Code;

12 (8) a chemical dependency treatment facility licensed
13 under Chapter 464, Health and Safety Code;

14 (8-a) a narcotic drug treatment program authorized
15 under Chapter 466, Health and Safety Code;

16 (9) a mental hospital or mental health facility
17 licensed under Chapter 577, Health and Safety Code;

18 (10) a child-care facility or child-placing agency
19 licensed under or a family home listed or registered under Chapter
20 42, Human Resources Code; or

21 (11) an adult day-care facility licensed under Chapter
22 103, Human Resources Code.

23 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
