8	than the 45th day after the date a child enters the conservatorship
9	of the department, the child shall receive a developmentally
10	appropriate, comprehensive psychosocial assessment. The assessment
11	<pre>must include:</pre>
12	(1) a screening for trauma; and
13	(2) interviews with individuals who have knowledge of
14	the child's needs.
15	(b) The department shall develop:
16	(1) a schedule of approved assessment tools that may
17	be used in the performance of an assessment; and
18	(2) guidelines regarding the contents of an assessment
