## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

2 relating to the employment of certified school counselors by school

3 districts.

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4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 33.002, Education Code, is amended to

6 read as follows:

7 Sec. 33.002. CERTIFIED SCHOOL COUNSELOR. (a) From funds 8 appropriated for the purpose or other funds that may be used for the

purpose, the commissioner shall distribute funds for programs under

O this subchapter. In distributing those funds, the commissioner

shall give preference to [a school district that received funds

12 under this subsection for the preceding school year and then to] the

districts that have the highest concentration of students at risk

14 of dropping out of school, as described by Section 29.081. To

15 receive funds for the program, a school district must apply to the

16 commissioner. For each school year that a school district receives

17 funds under this subsection, the district shall allocate an amount

18 of local funds for school guidance and counseling programs that is

19 equal to or greater than the amount of local funds that the school

20 district allocated for that purpose during the preceding school

21 year. Funds distributed under this subsection are in addition to

22 any other funds available for programs under this subchapter,

23 including funds provided under Section 42.2519 [This section

24 applies only to a school district that receives funds as provided by

- 1 this subsection].
- 2 (b) A school district with 300 [500] or more students in
- 3 enrollment [enrolled in elementary school grades] shall employ a
- 4 school counselor certified under the rules of the State Board for
- 5 Educator Certification for each [elementary] school in the
- 6 district. A school district shall employ at least one school
- 7 counselor for every 300 [500 elementary school] students in the
- 8 district.
- 9 (c) A school district with fewer than 300 [500] students in
- 10 <u>enrollment</u> [enrolled in elementary school grades] shall provide
- 11 guidance and counseling services to [elementary school] students
- 12 by:
- 13 (1) employing a part-time school counselor certified
- 14 under the rules of the State Board for Educator Certification;
- 15 (2) employing a part-time teacher certified as a
- 16 school counselor under the rules of the State Board for Educator
- 17 Certification; or
- 18 (3) entering into a shared services arrangement
- 19 agreement with one or more school districts to share a school
- 20 counselor certified under the rules of the State Board for Educator
- 21 Certification.
- SECTION 2. Subchapter E, Chapter 42, Education Code, is
- 23 amended by adding Section 42.2519 to read as follows:
- Sec. 42.2519. ADDITIONAL STATE AID FOR CERTIFIED SCHOOL
- 25 COUNSELORS. (a) For each school year, from funds that may be used
- 26 for the purpose, a school district is entitled to state aid in an
- 27 amount, as determined by the commissioner, sufficient to assist the

- 1 district in employing the number of certified school counselors
- 2 required by Section 33.002.
- 3 (b) The amount of state aid to which a school district is
- 4 entitled under this section is in addition to the amount of revenue
- 5 to which the district is entitled under Section 42.2516(b). This
- 6 subsection expires September 1, 2017.
- 7 (c) The commissioner shall adopt rules as necessary to
- 8 <u>administer this section.</u>
- 9 SECTION 3. This Act applies beginning with the 2015-2016
- 10 school year.
- 11 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
