## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to the financial self-sufficiency of the Cancer Prevention
- 3 and Research Institute of Texas.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 102, Health and Safety
- 6 Code, is amended by adding Section 102.005 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 102.005. FINANCIAL SELF-SUFFICIENCY PLAN. (a) The
- 8 institute shall develop a plan that specifies how the institute
- 9 will become financially self-sufficient and continue to operate
- 10 without state funding with the exception of patent royalties and
- 11 license revenues realized as a result of projects undertaken with
- 12 money awarded under Subchapter E.
- 13 (b) The plan described by Subsection (a) must:
- 14 (1) specify the steps the institute will take to
- 15 accomplish the transition to financial self-sufficiency after
- 16 issuance of the \$3 bil<u>lion in general obligation bonds authorized</u>
- 17 by Article III, Section 67 of the Texas Constitution;
- 18 (2) specify sources of funding other than state money
- 19 to be used to operate the institute after issuance of the \$3 billion
- 20 in general obligation bonds authorized by Article III, Section 67
- 21 of the Texas Constitution; and
- 22 (3) describe how the institute will structure
- 23 state-funded grants, to ensure that all grants that use state money
- 24 are closed out when the last of the \$3 billion in general obligation

- 1 bonds authorized by Article III, Section 67 of the Texas
- 2 Constitution is used to reimburse grant awardees for allowable
- 3 expenditures pursuant to institute award contract terms.
- 4 (c) The institute shall submit the initial plan to the
- 5 legislature not later than December 1, 2016. The institute shall
- 6 submit an updated plan before December 1 of each subsequent year.
- 7 (d) This section expires September 1, 2021.
- 8 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 9 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 10 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 11 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 12 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
