- 4 SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 38, Education Code, is

- 6 Sec. 38.021. USE OF SUNSCREEN PRODUCTS. (a) A student may
- 7 possess and use a topical sunscreen product while on school
- 8 property or at a school-related event or activity to avoid
- 9 overexposure to the sun and not for the medical treatment of an
- 10 injury or illness if the product is approved by the federal Food and
- 11 Drug Administration for over-the-counter use.
- 12 (b) This section does not:
- (1) waive any immunity from liability of a school
- 14 district, its board of trustees, or its employees; or
- 15 (2) create any liability for or a cause of action
- 16 against a school district, its board of trustees, or its employees.
- 17 SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2015-2016
- 18 school year.
- 19 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 20 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 21 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 22 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 23 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
