- 7 Sec. 250.007. REGULATION OF RENTAL OR LEASING OF HOUSING
- 8 ACCOMMODATIONS. Except as provided by this section, a municipality
- 9 or county may not adopt or enforce an ordinance or regulation that
- 10 prohibits an owner, lessee, sublessee, assignee, managing agent, or
- 11 other person having the right to lease, sublease, or rent a housing
- 12 accommodation from refusing to lease or rent the housing
- 13 accommodation to a person because the person's lawful source of
- 14 income to pay rent includes funding from a federal housing
- 15 assistance program.
- 16 (b) This section does not affect an ordinance or regulation
- 17 that prohibits the refusal to lease or rent a housing accommodation
- 18 to a military veteran because of the veteran's lawful source of
- 19 income to pay rent.
- 20 (c) This section does not affect any authority of a
- 21 municipality or county or decree to create or implement an
- 22 <u>incentive</u>, contract commitment, density bonus, or other voluntary
- 23 program designed to encourage the acceptance of a housing voucher
- 24 directly or indirectly funded by the federal government, including
