A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT 2 relating to the jurisdiction of a county court at law in Tarrant 3 County. Δ BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 5 SECTION 1. Section 25.2222(a), Government Code, is amended 6 to read as follows: 7 (a) A county court at law in Tarrant County has jurisdiction over all civil matters and causes, original and appellate, 8 prescribed by law for county courts. The County Court at Law No. 1 9 of Tarrant County also has jurisdiction over all criminal matters 10 and causes, original and appellate, prescribed by law for county 11 12 courts. The County Courts at Law Nos. 2 and 3 of Tarrant County do 13 not have criminal jurisdiction. Notwithstanding any other provision, a county court at law in Tarrant County has jurisdiction 14 15 on any appeal from a municipal court of record in Tarrant County that is not an appeal of a criminal law case or proceeding. 16 17 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
