4	SECTION 1. Section 7.056(e), Education Code, is amended to

- 24 number of days of operation, including any time required for staff

- 26 otherwise required by law;

- 8 SECTION 3. Section 151.326(a), Tax Code, is amended to read
- 9 as follows:
- 10 (a) The sale of an article of clothing or footwear designed
- 11 to be worn on or about the human body is exempted from the taxes
- 12 imposed by this chapter if:
- 13 (1) the sales price of the article is less than \$100;
- 14 and
- 15 (2) the sale takes place during a period beginning at
- 16 12:01 a.m. on the third Friday in August [before the 15th day
- 17 preceding the uniform date prescribed by Section 25.0811(a),
- 18 Education Code, without regard to any exception authorized by that
- 19 section, before which a school district may not begin instruction
- 20 for the school year, and ending at 12 midnight on the following
- 21 Sunday.
- 22 SECTION 4. Section 25.0811, Education Code, is repealed.
- 23 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
