- 2 relating to the certification of certain peace officers to enforce
- 3 commercial motor vehicle safety standards.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 644.101(b), Transportation Code, is
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 (b) A police officer of any of the following municipalities
- 8 is eligible to apply for certification under this section:
- 9 (1) a municipality with a population of 50,000 or
- 10 more;
- 11 (2) a municipality with a population of 25,000 or more
- 12 any part of which is located in a county with a population of
- 13 500,000 or more;
- 14 (3) a municipality with a population of less than
- 15 25,000:
- 16 (A) any part of which is located in a county with
- 17 a population of 3.3 million; and
- 18 (B) that contains or is adjacent to an
- 19 international port;
- 20 (4) a municipality with a population of at least
- 21 34,000 that is located in a county that borders two or more states;
- 22 (5) a municipality any part of which is located in a
- 23 county bordering the United Mexican States;
- 24 (6) a municipality with a population of less than

- 1 5,000 that is located:
- 2 (A) adjacent to a bay connected to the Gulf of
- 3 Mexico; and
- 4 (B) in a county adjacent to a county with a
- 5 population greater than 3.3 million;
- 6 (7) a municipality that is located:
- 7 (A) within 25 miles of an international port; and
- 8 (B) in a county that does not contain a highway
- 9 that is part of the national system of interstate and defense
- 10 highways and is adjacent to a county with a population greater than
- 11 3.3 million; [or]
- 12 (8) a municipality with a population of less than
- 13 8,500 that:
- 14 (A) is the county seat; and
- 15 (B) contains a highway that is part of the
- 16 national system of interstate and defense highways; or
- 17 (9) a municipality located in a county with a
- 18 population between 60,000 and 66,000 adjacent to a bay connected to
- 19 the Gulf of Mexico.
- 20 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 21 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 22 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 23 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 24 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
