11	effective consent of the owner; or

- 13 knowingly accesses a computer, computer network, or computer system
- 14 in violation of:
- 15 (A) a clear and conspicuous prohibition by the
- owner of the computer, computer network, or computer system; or
- 17 (B) a contractual agreement to which the person
- 18 <u>has expressly agreed</u>.
- 19 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 20 to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 21 An offense committed before the effective date of this Act is
- 22 governed by the law in effect when the offense was committed, and
- 23 the former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For
- 24 purposes of this section, an offense was committed before the

- 1 effective date of this Act if any element of the offense occurred
- 2 before that date.
- 3 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
