4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Section 252.010, Occupations Code, is amended by
6	adding Subsections (b-1) and (b-2) to read as follows:
7	(b-1) The board shall adopt a training manual for board
8	members. The executive director shall provide the manual to each
9	board member each year and to each person appointed to the board
10	during the training program under Subsection (a). The manual must
11	include, at a minimum:
12	(1) the scope of and limitations on the rulemaking
13	authority of the board;
14	(2) the distinction between the board's rulemaking
15	authority and the authority of the legislature; and
16	(3) board rules and other applicable state laws.
17	(b-2) A member of the board shall submit to the executive
18	director annually a statement affirming receipt of the member
19	training manual.
20	SECTION 2. Chapter 252, Occupations Code, is amended by
21	adding Section 252.012 to read as follows:
22	Sec. 252.012. CODE OF CONDUCT. (a) The board by rule shall
23	adopt a code of conduct applicable to each member of the board.
24	(b) At a minimum, the code of conduct must specify:

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1 (1) the ethical considerations involved in 2 communications between the board and persons required to register as lobbyists under Chapter 305, Government Code; 3 4 (2) the procedures by which a member of the board shall 5 disclose a conflict of interest; and 6 (3) the importance of transparency and 7 professionalism during regularly scheduled board meetings and in 8 interactions with the public. 9 (c) The executive director shall provide the code of conduct to each board member each year. A member of the board shall submit 10 to the executive director annually a statement affirming: 11 12 (1) receipt of the code of conduct; and (2) adherence to the code of conduct in the 13 14 performance of the member's duties. 15 SECTION 3. Not later than December 1, 2015, the State Board of Dental Examiners shall adopt rules necessary to implement 16 17 Section 252.012, Occupations Code, as added by this Act. SECTION 4. Not later than June 1, 2016, the State Board of 18 Dental Examiners shall adopt the training manual under Section 19 252.010(b-1), Occupations Code, as added by this Act. 20 21 SECTION 5. Not later than December 1, 2016, the state auditor shall conduct a review to assess whether the State Board of 22 Dental Examiners has exceeded its statutory authority and whether 23 the board is in compliance with this Act. The state auditor shall 24 25 make available on the auditor's Internet website a report on the 26 auditor's findings from the review conducted under this section and report the results of the review to the governor, the lieutenant 27

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1 governor, the speaker of the house of representatives, the chair of 2 the Senate Health and Human Services Committee, and the chair of the 3 House Public Health Committee.

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4 SECTION 6. The change in law made by this Act to Section 5 252.010, Occupations Code, regarding the training program of the 6 State Board of Dental Examiners, does not affect the entitlement of 7 a member serving on the board immediately before the date the board 8 adopts the training manual under Section 252.010(b-1), Occupations 9 Code, as added by this Act, to continue to serve as a member of the 10 board for the remainder of the member's term.

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SECTION 7. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.

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
