- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 13, Election Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 13.009 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 13.009. ISSUANCE OF RECEIPT. (a) This section applies
- 8 only to a completed registration application that is submitted by
- 9 the applicant in person to a voter registrar, deputy registrar, or
- 10 volunteer deputy registrar or a voter registration agency
- 11 designated under Chapter 20. This section does not apply to a
- 12 completed registration application that is submitted by mail.
- (b) On receipt of a completed registration application, the
- 14 person receiving the application shall prepare a receipt in
- 15 duplicate on a form prescribed by the secretary of state and
- 16 furnished by the registrar.
- 17 (c) The receipt must contain:
- 18 (1) the name of the applicant and, if applicable, the
- 19 name of the applicant's agent; and
- 20 (2) the date the completed application is submitted.
- 21 (d) The person receiving the application shall sign the
- 22 receipt in the applicant's presence and shall give the original to
- 23 the applicant.
- (e) The person receiving the application shall deliver the

- 1 duplicate receipt to the registrar with the registration
- 2 application. The registrar shall retain the receipt on file with
- 3 the application.
- 4 (f) The secretary of state may prescribe a procedure that is
- 5 <u>an alternative to the procedure prescribed by this section that</u>
- 6 will ensure the accountability of the registration applications.
- 7 SECTION 2. Section 13.040, Election Code, is repealed.
- 8 SECTION 3. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 9 to a voter registration application submitted on or after the
- 10 effective date of this Act.
- 11 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
