A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to the abolishment of the Orange County child support
- 3 office and to the divorce and contempt fees paid in Orange County.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Sections 152.1872(f) and (g), Human Resources
- 6 Code, are transferred to Section 152.1873, Human Resources Code,
- 7 redesignated as Subsections (f) and (g) of that section, and
- 8 amended to read as follows:
- 9 (f) Fees collected under this section [and Section
- 10 152.1873] shall be deposited in a separate fund known as the
- 11 "divorce and contempt fees fund [Child Support Fund]" by the county
- 12 treasurer. A record shall be kept of all fees collected and
- 13 expended. The <u>divorce and contempt fees</u> [child support] fund is
- 14 subject to regular audit by the county auditor or other authorized
- 15 person. An annual report of receipts and expenditures in the
- 16 account shall be made to the commissioners court by the auditor.
- 17 (g) The Orange County Juvenile Board [juvenile board] shall
- 18 administer the fees collected under this section [and Section
- 19 152.1873] to meet the expenses of the <u>juvenile board</u> [office],
- 20 including postage, equipment, stationery, office supplies,
- 21 subpoenas, salaries, and other expenses authorized by the board.
- 22 The fund shall be supplemented from the general fund or other
- 23 available funds of the county as necessary.
- SECTION 2. The heading to Section 152.1873, Human Resources

- 1 Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 2 Sec. 152.1873. DIVORCE [ADOPTION] AND CONTEMPT FEES IN
- 3 ORANGE COUNTY.
- 4 SECTION 3. Sections 152.1873(a) and (d), Human Resources
- 5 Code, are amended to read as follows:
- 6 (a) Each person who files a divorce case in Orange County
- 7 shall pay to the clerk of the district court a filing fee of not less
- 8 than \$5. The fee is taxed, collected, and paid as other costs and is
- 9 used to assist in maintaining the Orange County Juvenile Board as
- 10 provided by Subsection (g) [child support office].
- 11 (d) A receipt of all disbursements of money paid to [into]
- 12 the Orange County Juvenile Board [child support office] in a matter
- 13 involving contempt shall be kept on file.
- 14 SECTION 4. The following are repealed:
- 15 (1) the heading to Section 152.1872, Human Resources
- 16 Code; and
- 17 (2) Sections 152.1872(a), (b), (c), (d), and (e),
- 18 Human Resources Code.
- 19 SECTION 5. On the effective date of this Act:
- 20 (1) the Orange County child support office is
- 21 abolished;
- 22 (2) the obligations, rights, records, equipment, and
- 23 personnel of the former office are transferred to the Orange County
- 24 Juvenile Board; and
- 25 (3) any money remaining in the Orange County child
- 26 support fund shall be transferred to the divorce and contempt fees
- 27 fund for the Orange County Juvenile Board.

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1 SECTION 6. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
