 1-20 AN ACT

1-21 relating to public school educator continuing education credit for  
 1-22 instruction on the use of an automated external defibrillator.

1-23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-24 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 21, Education Code, is  
 1-25 amended by adding Section 21.0541 to read as follows:

1-26 Sec. 21.0541. CONTINUING EDUCATION CREDIT FOR INSTRUCTION  
 1-27 RELATED TO USE OF AUTOMATED EXTERNAL DEFIBRILLATOR. The board  
 1-28 shall adopt rules allowing an educator to receive credit towards  
 1-29 the educator's continuing education requirements for completion of  
 1-30 an instructional course on the use of an automated external  
 1-31 defibrillator that meets the guidelines for automated external  
 1-32 defibrillator training approved under Section 779.002, Health and  
 1-33 Safety Code.

1-34 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives  
 1-35 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as  
 1-36 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this  
 1-37 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this  
 1-38 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
