A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to equal opportunity for access by home-schooled students to University Interscholastic League sponsored activities; 3 authorizing a fee. 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter D, Chapter 33, Education Code, is 6 7 amended by adding Section 33.0832 to read as follows: Sec. 33.0832. EQUAL OPPORTUNITY FOR HOME-SCHOOLED STUDENTS 8 TO PARTICIPATE IN UNIVERSITY INTERSCHOLASTIC LEAGUE ACTIVITIES. 9 (a) Except as provided by Subsection (d), a public school that 10 participates in an activity sponsored by the University 11 Interscholastic League shall provide a home-schooled student who 12 resides in the school's attendance area with the opportunity to 13 participate in the activity on behalf of the school in the same 14 manner that the school provides the opportunity to participate to 15 16 students enrolled in the school. (b) A home-schooled student who seeks to participate or who 17 participates in a league activity on behalf of a school is subject 18 to the relevant policies that apply to students enrolled in the 19 school, including policies regarding registration, age 20 eligibility, fees, insurance, transportation, physical condition, 21 qualifications, responsibilities, event schedules, standards of 22 23 behavior, and performance. 24 (c) As a condition of participation by a home-schooled

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student in a league activity under this section, the individual who 1 primarily provides instruction to the student must submit a written 2 verification to the school indicating whether the student is: 3 4 (1) receiving a passing grade in each course or 5 subject taught; and 6 (2) maintaining satisfactory progress towards 7 academic advancement or promotion. 8 (d) A home-schooled student is not authorized by this section to participate in a league activity during the remainder of 9 any school year during which the student was previously enrolled in 10 a public school. 11 12 (e) The University Interscholastic League may not prohibit a home-schooled student from participating in league activities in 13 14 the manner authorized by this section. 15 SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2015-2016 school year. 16 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 17 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 18 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 19 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 20 Act takes effect September 1, 2015. 21

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
