## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to the liability of a political subdivision of this state
3	for certain claims relating to land acquired by the political
4	subdivision under certain circumstances.
5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
6	SECTION 1. Section 101.064, Civil Practice and Remedies
7	Code, is amended to read as follows:
8	Sec. 101.064. LAND ACQUIRED UNDER FORECLOSURE OF LIEN OR BY
9	CONVEYANCE IN SATISFACTION OF CERTAIN TAX DEBT. (a) This section
10	applies only to a political subdivision of this state
11	[municipality] that acquires land:
12	(1) as a result of [at a sale following] the
13	foreclosure of a lien held by the political subdivision, including
14	land that was bid off to the political subdivision under Section
15	34.01, Tax Code; or
16	(2) under Section 31.061, Tax Code [municipality].
17	(b) This chapter does not apply to a claim that:
18	(1) arises after the date the land was acquired and
19	before the date the land is sold, conveyed, or exchanged by the
20	<pre>political subdivision [municipality]; and</pre>
21	(2) arises from:
22	(A) the condition of the land;
23	(B) a premises defect on the land; or
24	(C) an action committed by any person, other than

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- 1 an agent or employee of the political subdivision [municipality],
- 2 on the land.
- 3 (c) In this section, [the term] "land" includes any building
- 4 or improvement located on land acquired by a political subdivision
- 5 [municipality].
- 6 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 7 to a claim that arises on or after the effective date of this Act,
- 8 regardless of whether the land was acquired by a political
- 9 subdivision before, on, or after the effective date of this Act. A
- 10 claim that arises before the effective date of this Act is governed
- 11 by the law applicable to the claim immediately before the effective
- 12 date of this Act, and that law is continued in effect for that
- 13 purpose.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
