AN ACT

- 2 relating to administering the Texas Success Initiative assessment
- 3 instrument to certain public school students.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 28, Education Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 28.0081 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 28.0081. ADMINISTRATION OF ASSESSMENT INSTRUMENT FOR
- 8 DIAGNOSTIC PURPOSES. Not later than April 1 of each school year, a
- 9 school district shall administer an assessment instrument
- 10 designated by the Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board under
- 11 Section 51.3062(c) to each student in the district enrolled in the
- 12 10th grade. A student's performance on the assessment instrument
- 13 may only be used for diagnostic purposes, including a determination
- 14 as to whether a student should be enrolled in developmental
- 15 education courses. If a student is in a special education program
- 16 under Subchapter A, Chapter 29, the student's admission, review,
- 17 and dismissal committee shall determine if it is appropriate for
- 18 the student to be administered the assessment instrument required
- 19 under this section.
- 20 SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2015-2016
- 21 school year.

- 22 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 23 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 24 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this

- 1 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 2 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
