S.B. No. 453

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT  
2 relating to minimum scores required for public school students to  
3 receive credit by an examination administered through the  
4 College-Level Examination Program.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

6 SECTION 1. Section 28.023(c-1), Education Code, is amended  
7 to read as follows:

8 (c-1) A school district shall give a student in grade level  
9 six or above credit for a subject if the student scores:

10 (1) a three or higher on an advanced placement  
11 examination approved by the board of trustees under Subsection (a)  
12 and developed by the College Board; or

13 (2) a scaled score of 50 [~~60~~] or higher on an  
14 examination approved by the board of trustees under Subsection (a)  
15 and administered through the College-Level Examination Program.

16 SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2015-2016  
17 school year.

18 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives  
19 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as  
20 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this  
21 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this  
22 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
