- six or above credit for a subject if the student scores: 9
- 10 (1) a three or higher on an advanced placement
- examination approved by the board of trustees under Subsection (a) 11
- 12 and developed by the College Board; or
- 13 (2) a scaled score of 50 [60] or higher on
- 14 examination approved by the board of trustees under Subsection (a)
- 15 and administered through the College-Level Examination Program.
- SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2015-2016 16
- 17 school year.
