- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 28.023(c-1), Education Code, is amended
- 7 to read as follows:
- 8 (c-1) A school district shall give a student in grade level
- 9 six or above credit for a subject if the student scores:
- 10 (1) a three or higher on an advanced placement
- 11 examination approved by the board of trustees under Subsection (a)
- 12 and developed by the College Board; or
- 13 (2) a scaled score of 50 [60] or higher on an
- 14 examination approved by the board of trustees under Subsection (a)
- 15 and administered through the College-Level Examination Program.
- SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2015-2016
- 17 school year.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 19 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 20 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 21 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 22 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
