1-17 relating to minimum scores required for public school students to
 1-18 receive credit by an examination administered through the
 1-19 College-Level Examination Program.

1-20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-21 SECTION 1. Section 28.023(c-1), Education Code, is amended
 1-22 to read as follows:

1-23 (c-1) A school district shall give a student in grade level
 1-24 six or above credit for a subject if the student scores:

1-25 (1) a three or higher on an advanced placement
 1-26 examination approved by the board of trustees under Subsection (a)
 1-27 and developed by the College Board; or

1-28 (2) a scaled score of 50 [~~60~~] or higher on an
 1-29 examination approved by the board of trustees under Subsection (a)
 1-30 and administered through the College-Level Examination Program.

1-31 SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2015-2016
 1-32 school year.

1-33 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
 1-34 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
 1-35 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
 1-36 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
 1-37 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
