11	the case of a municipality with fewer than 5,000 inhabitants;

14	(3) within two miles of those boundaries, in the case
15	of a municipality with 25,000 to 49,999 inhabitants;
16	[(4)] within 3-1/2 miles of those boundaries, in the
17	case of a municipality with 50,000 to 99,999 inhabitants; or
18	[(5) within five miles of those boundaries, in the
19	case of a municipality with 100,000 or more inhabitants].
20	SECTION 2. Section 42.903(b), Local Government Code, is

- 9 5,000 or more and is located in a county bordering the Rio Grande
