## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 2 relating to the eligibility of certain persons for the supplemental

- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 33, Human Resources Code,
- 6 is amended by adding Section 33.018 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 33.018. INAPPLICABILITY OF CERTAIN FEDERAL LAW IN
- 8 DETERMINING ELIGIBILITY. As authorized by 21 U.S.C. Section
- 9 862a(d)(1)(A), 21 U.S.C. Section 862a(a) does not apply in
- 10 determining the eligibility of a person for the supplemental
- 11 nutrition assistance program.
- 12 SECTION 2. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to
- 13 a determination of eligibility of a person for supplemental
- 14 nutrition assistance benefits made on or after the effective date
- 15 of this Act. A determination of eligibility made before the
- 16 effective date of this Act is governed by the law in effect on the
- 17 date the determination was made, and the former law is continued in
- 18 effect for that purpose.
- 19 SECTION 3. If before implementing any provision of this Act
- 20 a state agency determines that a waiver or authorization from a
- 21 federal agency is necessary for implementation of that provision,
- 22 the agency affected by the provision shall request the waiver or
- 23 authorization and may delay implementing that provision until the
- 24 waiver or authorization is granted.
