1-19 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
 1-20 AN ACT

1-21 relating to the designation of a portion of U.S. Highway 87 in
 1-22 Howard County as the William B. Crooker Memorial Highway.

1-23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-24 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 225, Transportation Code,
 1-25 is amended by adding Section 225.102 to read as follows:

1-26 Sec. 225.102. WILLIAM B. CROOKER MEMORIAL HIGHWAY.

1-27 (a) Notwithstanding Section 225.001(c), the portion of U.S.
 1-28 Highway 87 under construction as of September 1, 2015, as a relief
 1-29 route around Big Spring, between Interstate Highway 20 and Ranch
 1-30 Road 33, in Howard County is designated as the William B. Crooker
 1-31 Memorial Highway. The designation is in addition to any other
 1-32 designation.

1-33 (b) Subject to Section 225.021(c), the department shall:

1-34 (1) design and construct markers indicating the
 1-35 designation as the William B. Crooker Memorial Highway and any
 1-36 other appropriate information; and

1-37 (2) erect a marker at each end of the highway and at
 1-38 appropriate intermediate sites along the highway.

1-39 SECTION 2. The Texas Department of Transportation shall
 1-40 comply with Section 225.102, Transportation Code, as added by this
 1-41 Act, after the construction of the portion of U.S. Highway 87
 1-42 designated as the William B. Crooker Memorial Highway by this Act is
 1-43 complete.

1-44 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.

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
