5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
6	SECTION 1. Subtitle A, Title 5, Business & Commerce Code, is
7	amended by adding Chapter 73 to read as follows:
8	CHAPTER 73. REGISTRATION OF DENTAL SUPPORT ORGANIZATIONS
9	Sec. 73.001. DEFINITIONS. In this chapter:
10	(1) "Business support services" means business,
11	management, consulting, or administrative services, facilities, or
12	staff provided for a dentist, including:
13	(A) office space, furnishings, and equipment;
14	(B) staff employed by the dental support
15	organization;
16	(C) regulatory compliance;
17	(D) inventory or supplies, including dental
18	equipment and supplies;
19	(E) information systems;
20	(F) marketing and advertising;
21	(G) financial services;
22	(H) accounting, bookkeeping, or monitoring or
23	payment of accounts receivable;
24	(I) payroll or benefits administration;

S.B. No. 519 1 (J) billing and collection for services and 2 products; 3 reporting and payment of federal or state (K) 4 taxes; 5 (L) administration of interest expense or indebtedness incurred to finance the operation of a business; or 6 7 (M) insurance services. (2) "Dental support organization" means an entity 8 9 that, under an agreement, provides two or more business support services to a dentist. 10 (3) 11 "Dentist" means an individual licensed to practice dentistry in this state. 12 13 Sec. 73.002. REGISTRATION REQUIRED. (a) A dental support organization shall annually register with the secretary of state. 14 15 (b) A dental support organization's registration under this 16 section is considered registration of any subsidiary, contractor, or affiliate of the dental support organization through or with 17 which the dental support organization provides business support 18 services. 19 20 Sec. 73.003. EXEMPTIONS. This chapter does not require 21 registration by: 22 (1) an accountant providing only accounting services; 23 (2) an attorney providing only legal counsel; (3) an insurance company or insurance agent providing 24 25 only insurance policies to a business; and (4) entities providing only investment and financial 26 27 advisory services.

1	Sec. 73.004. CONTENTS OF REGISTRATION; FEE. (a) The
2	registration required by Section 73.002 must include:
3	(1) the name and business address of the dental
4	support organization;
5	(2) the name and business address of each dentist in
6	this state with which the dental support organization has entered
7	into an agreement to provide two or more business support services;
8	(3) the name of each dentist who owns 10 percent or
9	more of the dental support organization;
10	(4) the name of each person who is not a dentist and
11	owns 10 percent or more of the dental support organization; and
12	(5) a list of all business support services provided
13	to each dentist.
14	(b) A registration and each corrected registration must be
15	accompanied by a fee set by the secretary of state in an amount
16	necessary to recover the costs of administering this chapter.
17	(c) A registration or corrected registration is not
18	effective until the dental support organization pays the fee
19	required by this section.
20	Sec. 73.005. TIMING OF REGISTRATION; CORRECTION REQUIRED.
21	(a) Except as provided by Subsection (b), the registration
22	required by Section 73.002 must be filed with the secretary of state
23	not later than January 31 of each year for which the registration is
24	effective.
25	(b) A dental support organization that initially meets the
26	requirement for registration under Section 73.002 after January 31
27	shall file the registration required by that section not later than

1	the 90th day after the date an agreement to provide business support
2	services is executed.
3	(c) A dental support organization shall file a corrected
4	registration each quarter as necessary.
5	Sec. 73.006. FAILURE TO FILE REGISTRATION OR CORRECTION.
6	(a) A person who fails to file a registration or a corrected
7	registration as required by this chapter is liable to the state for
8	a civil penalty in an amount not to exceed \$1,000.
9	(b) Each day a violation continues or occurs is a separate
10	violation for the purpose of imposing the civil penalty.
11	(c) The attorney general shall file suit to collect the
12	civil penalty provided by this section. The suit may be filed in
13	Travis County or any county where the dental support organization
14	provides business support services.
15	Sec. 73.007. INTERAGENCY MEMORANDUM. The secretary of
16	state and the State Board of Dental Examiners shall enter into an
17	interagency memorandum to share the information collected by the
18	secretary of state under this chapter with the board.
19	Sec. 73.008. APPLICABILITY. This chapter does not limit
20	nonclinical business support services that may be provided to a
21	dentist by a dental support organization.
22	SECTION 2. Sections 254.019(a), (b), and (c), Occupations
23	Code, are amended to read as follows:
24	(a) In this section:
25	(1) <u>"Business support services" has the meaning</u>
26	assigned by Section 73.001, Business & Commerce Code ["Dental
27	service agreement" means an agreement between a dental service

1 organization and a dentist under which the dental service organization will: 2 [(A) provide services related to the nonclinical 3 business aspects of a dental practice, including arranging or 4 providing financing, performing billing or payroll tasks, 5 processing patient insurance claims, scheduling or otherwise 6 7 interacting with patients, and performing other administrative tasks; 8 9 [(B) supervise or manage the employees contractors of the dentist; or 10 [(C) employ or otherwise contract with a dentist 11 in the dentist's capacity as a dentist]. 12 "Dental support [service] organization" has the 13 (2) meaning assigned by Section 73.001, Business & Commerce Code [means 14 an entity that: 15 16 [(A) is owned wholly or partly by a person who is 17 is not a dentist; and 18 [(B) under a dental service agreement, provides or offers to provide services to a dentist or employs or otherwise 19 contracts with a dentist in the dentist's capacity as a dentist]. 20 The board shall collect the following information from 21 (b) dentists licensed by the board in conjunction with the issuance and 22 renewal of each dental license: 23 (1) the number and type of dentists employed by the 24 25 license holder, if any; (2) the name under which the license holder provides 26 dental services and each location at which those services are 27

1 provided by that license holder;

(3) whether the license holder is a participating
provider under the Medicaid program operated under Chapter 32,
Human Resources Code, or the child health plan program operated
under Chapter 62, Health and Safety Code;

6 (4) whether the license holder [is employed by or]
7 contracts or enters into an agreement for business support services
8 with a dental support [service] organization and, if so, the name
9 and address of the dental support [service] organization;

10 (5) whether the license holder owns all or part of a 11 dental <u>support</u> [service] organization and, if so, the name and 12 address of the dental <u>support</u> [service] organization and of each 13 dental office at which the dental <u>support</u> [service] organization 14 provides services to patients;

15 (6) whether the license holder is a party to a dental 16 <u>support</u> [service] agreement and, if so, the name and address of the 17 dental <u>support</u> [service] organization that provides services under 18 the agreement; and

(7) if the license holder owns all or part of a dental support [service] organization, whether the license holder's [that] practice is a party to a dental support [service] agreement and, if so, the name and address of the dental support [service] organization that provides services under the agreement.

(c) If requested by the board, a dental <u>support</u> [service]
organization shall provide to the board the address of the
locations where the organization provides <u>business support</u>
[dental] services in this state and the name of each dentist

1 providing dental services at each location.

2 SECTION 3. Notwithstanding Section 73.002, Business & 3 Commerce Code, as added by this Act, a dental support organization 4 is not required to register under that section before February 1, 5 2016.

6 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
