3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
4	SECTION 1. SUNSET ACT. Chapter 325, Government Code, is
5	amended by adding Section 325.025 to read as follows:
6	Sec. 325.025. RIVER AUTHORITIES SUBJECT TO REVIEW. (a) A
7	river authority listed in Subsection (b) is subject to a limited
8	review under this chapter as if it were a state agency but may not be
9	abolished.
10	(b) This section applies to the:
11	(1) Angelina and Neches River Authority;
12	(2) Bandera County River Authority and Groundwater
13	District;
14	(3) Brazos River Authority;
15	(4) Central Colorado River Authority;
16	(5) Guadalupe-Blanco River Authority;
17	(6) Lavaca-Navidad River Authority;
18	(7) Lower Colorado River Authority;
19	(8) Lower Neches Valley Authority;
20	(9) Nueces River Authority;
21	(10) Palo Duro River Authority of Texas;
22	(11) Red River Authority of Texas;
23	(12) Sabine River Authority of Texas;
24	(13) San Antonio River Authority;

(14) San Jacinto River Authority; 1 2 (15) Sulphur River Basin Authority; 3 (16) Trinity River Authority of Texas; 4 (17) Upper Colorado River Authority; and (18) Upper Guadalupe River Authority. 5 (c) The limited review under this chapter must assess each 6 7 river authority's: 8 (1) governance; 9 (2) management; (3) operating structure; and 10 11 (4) compliance with legislative requirements. (d) A river authority shall pay the cost incurred by the 12 13 commission in performing a review of the authority under this section. The commission shall determine the cost, and the 14 authority shall pay the amount promptly on receipt of a statement 15 16 from the commission detailing the cost. 17 (e) A river authority reviewed by the commission under this section may not be required to conduct a management audit under 18 Chapter 292, Title 30, <u>Texas Administrative Code</u>, during the 19 five-year period after the year in which, if the authority were a 20 state agency, the authority would be scheduled to be abolished 21 under this chapter. 22 SECTION 2. - 11 SECTION 21. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act takes effect
- 12 immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members
- 13 elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas
- 14 Constitution. If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for
- 15 immediate effect, this Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
