4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Section 82.037(a), Government Code, is amended
6	to read as follows:
7	(a) Each person admitted to practice law shall, before
8	receiving a license, take an oath that the person will:
9	(1) support the constitutions of the United States and
10	this state;
11	(2) honestly demean <u>oneself</u> [himself] in the practice
12	of law; [and]
13	(3) discharge the attorney's duty to <u>the attorney's</u>
14	[his] client to the best of the attorney's ability <u>; and</u>
15	(4) conduct oneself with integrity and civility in
16	dealing and communicating with the court and all parties.
17	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
18	a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
19	provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
20	Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
21	Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
