5	SECTION 1. The heading to Section 623.071, Transportation

7	Sec. 623.071. PERMIT TO MOVE CERTAIN [HEAVY] EQUIPMENT.
8	SECTION 2. Section 623.071, Transportation Code, is amended
9	by adding Subsection (c-1) to read as follows:
10	(c-1) The department may issue an annual permit that allows
11	a person to operate over a state highway or road a vehicle or
12	combination of vehicles that exceeds the length and height limits
13	provided by law, except that:

- (1) the maximum length allowed may not exceed 110
- 15 feet; and
- 16 (2) the maximum height allowed may not exceed 14 feet.
- SECTION 3. Sections 623.076(a) and (a-1), Transportation
- 18 Code, are amended to read as follows:
- 19 (a) An application for a permit under this subchapter must
- 20 be accompanied by a permit fee of:
- 21 (1) \$60 for a single-trip permit;
- 22 (2) \$120 for a permit that is valid for a period not

- 8 (a-1) The following amounts collected under Subsection (a)
