Sections 623.076(a) and (a-1), Transportation 17 Code, are amended to read as follows: 18 19 (a) An application for a permit under this subchapter must be accompanied by a permit fee of: 20 21 (1) \$60 for a single-trip permit; 22 (2) \$120 for a permit that is valid for a period not 23 exceeding 30 days; \$180 for a permit that is valid for a period of 31 24 (3)

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1 days or more but not exceeding 60 days;

2 (4) \$240 for a permit that is valid for a period of 61
3 days or more but not exceeding 90 days; [or]

4 (5) \$270 for a permit issued under Section 5 623.071(c)(1) or (2); or

6 (6) \$960 for a permit issued under Section 7 623.071(c-1).

8 (a-1) The following amounts collected under Subsection (a) 9 shall be deposited to the general revenue fund, 90 percent of the 10 remainder shall be deposited to the credit of the state highway 11 fund, and 10 percent of the remainder shall be deposited to the 12 credit of the Texas Department of Motor Vehicles fund:

20 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 21 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 22 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 23 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 24 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.

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
