4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

Transportation rest areas; creating a criminal offense.

- 5 SECTION 1. The heading to Subchapter F, Chapter 203,
- 6 Transportation Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 7 SUBCHAPTER F. USE [LEASE] OF CERTAIN PROPERTY
- 8 SECTION 2. Subchapter F, Chapter 203, Transportation Code,
- 9 is amended by adding Section 203.112 to read as follows:
- 10 Sec. 203.112. PROHIBITION OR RESTRICTION OF FIREWORKS AT
- 11 REST AREA. (a) In this section, "rest area" means public real
- 12 property designated as a rest area, comfort station, picnic area,
- 13 roadside park, or scenic overlook by the department.
- 14 (b) The commission by order shall prohibit or restrict the
- 15 <u>use of fireworks at a state highway rest area in the unincorporated</u>
- 16 area of a county if:

- 17 (1) the commissioners court of the county petitions
- 18 the commission to adopt the order; and
- 19 (2) the county pays the department for the costs of
- 20 designing, constructing, and erecting signs at the rest area giving
- 21 notice of the order.
- (c) After an order is adopted under Subsection (b), the
- 23 department shall erect signs at the rest area giving notice of the
- 24 order. If a sign is damaged or destroyed, the department shall

- 1 replace the sign if the county:
- 2 (1) submits to the department a written request for
- 3 replacement; and
- 4 (2) pays the department for the costs of constructing
- 5 and replacing the sign.
- 6 (d) A person who knowingly or intentionally violates a
- 7 prohibition or restriction established by an order adopted under
- 8 this section commits an offense. An offense under this subsection
- 9 <u>is a Class C misdemeanor.</u>
- 10 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
