## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to the content of detailed reports filed by lobbyists.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 305.0061, Government Code, is amended by
- 5 amending Subsections (a), (b), and (c), and adding Subsection (h)
- 6 to read as follows:
- 7 (a) If a registrant or a person on the registrant's behalf
- 8 and with the registrant's consent or ratification makes
- 9 expenditures that exceed \$50 [60 percent of the amount of the
- 10 legislative per diem in a day for transportation or lodging for a
- 11 member of the legislative or executive branch or for the immediate
- 12 family of a member of the legislative or executive branch, the
- 13 registrant shall also state the following on the report filed under
- 14 Section 305.006:
- 15 (1) the name of the member of the legislative or
- 16 executive branch in whose behalf the expenditure is made;
- 17 (2) the place and date of the transportation or
- 18 lodging; and
- 19 (3) the purpose of the transportation or lodging.
- 20 (b) If a registrant or a person on the registrant's behalf
- 21 and with the registrant's consent or ratification makes
- 22 expenditures that exceed \$50 [60 percent of the amount of the
- 23 legislative per diem in] a day for food and beverages for a member
- 24 of the legislative or executive branch or for the immediate family

- 1 of a member of the legislative or executive branch or makes
- 2 expenditures that exceed \$50 [60 percent of the amount of the
- 3 legislative per diem in] a day for entertainment for a member of the
- 4 legislative or executive branch or for the immediate family of a
- 5 member of the legislative or executive branch, the registrant shall
- 6 also state the following on the report filed under Section 305.006:
- 7 (1) the name of the member of the legislative or
- 8 executive branch in whose behalf the expenditure is made;
- 9 (2) the place and date of the expenditure; and
- 10 (3) the amount of the expenditure by the appropriate
- 11 category of the amount, as determined by the commission.
- 12 (c) If a registrant or a person on the registrant's behalf
- 13 and with the registrant's consent or ratification gives to a member
- 14 of the legislative or executive branch, or to the immediate family
- 15 of a member of the legislative or executive branch, a gift or an
- 16 award or memento, the value of which exceeds \$50 per gift, award, or
- 17 memento, the registrant shall also state the following on the
- 18 report filed under Section 305.006:
- 19 (1) the name of the member of the legislative or
- 20 executive branch in whose behalf the expenditure is made;
- 21 (2) a general description of the gift, award, or
- 22 memento; and
- 23 (3) the amount of the expenditure by the appropriate
- 24 category of the amount, as determined by the commission.
- 25 (h) If more than one registrant or persons acting on behalf
- 26 of more than one registrant and with each registrant's consent or
- 27 ratification collaborate to make an expenditure described by

- 1 Section 305.006(b) together, each registrant shall report the total
- 2 value of the shared expenditure as required by Subsection (a), (b),
- 3 or (c), if the total value of the shared expenditure exceeds the
- 4 amount provided under Subsection (a), (b), or (c).
- 5 SECTION 2. Section 305.024(a), Government Code, as amended
- 6 by Chapters 92 (S.B. 1011) and 206 (H.B. 1508), Acts of the 79th
- 7 Legislature, Regular Session, 2005, is reenacted and amended to
- 8 read as follows:
- 9 (a) Except as provided by Section 305.025, a person
- 10 registered under Section 305.005 or a person on the registrant's
- 11 behalf and with the registrant's consent or ratification may not
- 12 offer, confer, or agree to confer:
- 13 (1) to an individual described by Section
- 14 305.0062(a)(1), (2), (3), (4), or (5):
- 15 (A) a loan, including the guarantee or
- 16 endorsement of a loan; or
- 17 (B) a gift of cash or a negotiable instrument as
- 18 described by Section 3.104, Business & Commerce Code; or
- 19 (2) to an individual described by Section
- 20 305.0062(a)(1),(2),(3),(4),(5),(6), or (7):
- 21 (A) an expenditure for transportation and
- 22 lodging;
- 23 (B) an expenditure or series of expenditures for
- 24 entertainment that in the aggregate exceed \$500 in a calendar year;
- 25 (C) an expenditure or series of expenditures for
- 26 gifts that in the aggregate exceed \$500 in a calendar year;
- (D) an expenditure for an award or memento that

- 1 exceeds \$500; or
- 2 (E) an expenditure described by Section
- 3 305.006(b)(1), (2), (3), or (6) unless:
- 4  $\underline{\text{(i)}}$  [ $\frac{\text{(A)}}{\text{(i)}}$ ] the registrant is present at the
- 5 event; or
- 6 (ii)  $\left[\frac{B}{B}\right]$  the expenditure is for a gift of
- 7 food or beverages required to be reported under Section
- 8 305.006(b)(4) in accordance with Section 305.0061(e-1).
- 9 SECTION 3. Section 305.024, Government Code, is amended by
- 10 adding Subsection (d) to read as follows:
- 11 (d) The registrant shall notify a member of the legislative
- 12 or executive branch when the registrant has reported, as to that
- 13 member of the legislative or executive branch, expenditures that,
- 14 in the aggregate, equal the monetary limits for expenditures under
- 15 Subsection (a)(2).
- SECTION 4. Section 305.031(a), Government Code, is amended
- 17 to read as follows:
- 18 (a) A person commits an offense if the person intentionally
- 19 or knowingly violates a provision of this chapter other than
- 20 Section 305.022, 305.024(d), or 305.028. An offense under this
- 21 subsection is a Class A misdemeanor.
- 22 SECTION 5. Sections 305.0061(g) and 305.024(c), Government
- 23 Code, are repealed.
- SECTION 6. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to
- 25 a gift, award, or memento given to or expenditures for
- 26 transportation, lodging, food, beverages, or entertainment made
- 27 for a member of the legislative or executive branch or the immediate

- 1 family of a member of the legislative or executive branch on or
- 2 after the effective date of this Act. A gift, award, or memento
- 3 given to or an expenditure for transportation, lodging, food,
- 4 beverages, or entertainment made for a member of the legislative or
- 5 executive branch or the immediate family of a member of the
- 6 legislative or executive branch before the effective date of this
- 7 Act is governed by the law in effect on the date the gift, award, or
- 8 memento was given, or the date the expenditure for transportation,
- 9 lodging, food, beverages, or entertainment was made, and the former
- 10 law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 11 SECTION 7. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
