RECOVERY UNDER UNDERINSURED MOTORIST 24 COVERAGE. Underinsured motorist coverage must provide for payment,

1 <u>up to the underinsured motorist coverage limit</u>, to the insured of 2 all amounts that the insured is legally entitled to recover as 3 damages from owners or operators of underinsured motor vehicles 4 because of bodily injury or property damage. Those damages may be[-, 5 not to exceed the limit specified in the insurance policy, and] 6 reduced by the amount recovered or recoverable from the insurer of 7 the underinsured motor vehicle.

8 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 9 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 10 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 11 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 12 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
