- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 29.003(h), Government Code, is amended
- 6 to read as follows:
- 7 (h) A municipality with a population of $1.325 \left[\frac{1.9}{1.9}\right]$ million
- 8 or more and another municipality contiguous to that municipality
- 9 may enter into an agreement providing concurrent jurisdiction for
- 10 the municipal courts of either jurisdiction for all criminal cases
- 11 arising from offenses under state law that are:
- 12 (1) committed on the boundary of those municipalities
- 13 or within 200 yards of that boundary; and
- 14 (2) punishable by fine only.
- 15 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 16 to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 17 An offense committed before the effective date of this Act is
- 18 governed by the law in effect when the offense was committed, and
- 19 the former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For
- 20 purposes of this section, an offense was committed before the
- 21 effective date of this Act if any element of the offense occurred
- 22 before that date.
- 23 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 24 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as

- 1 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 2 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 3 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
