## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to audits of the music, film, television, and multimedia 3 fund. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 485, Government Code, is amended by adding Section 485.008 to read as follows: 6 Sec. 485.008. AUDITS OF MUSIC, FILM, TELEVISION, AND 7 MULTIMEDIA FUND. (a) The state auditor shall conduct 8 9 effectiveness, compliance, and economy and efficiency audits of the music, film, television, and multimedia fund. As part of the 10 audits, the state auditor may determine whether: 11 12 (1) money is disbursed in compliance with the requirements and purpose of this chapter; and 13 14 (2) the office monitors grant recipients to determine whether the recipients comply with the terms of any applicable 15 16 agreement and with the requirements of this chapter. (b) The office shall cooperate with the state auditor and 17 provide the state auditor with access to all records, confidential 18 or nonconfidential, necessary to conduct the audits under this 19 20 section. 21 (c) Not later than January 1, 2017, the state auditor shall prepare a written report for the audits conducted under this 22 23 section and file the report in accordance with Section 321.014. The report may include details on: 24
