 1-18 AN ACT

1-19 relating to the Texas Identification Number system.
 1-20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
 1-21 SECTION 1. Sections 403.039(a) and (b), Government Code,
 1-22 are amended to read as follows:
 1-23 (a) The comptroller shall assign a Texas Identification
 1-24 Number [~~, based on the comptroller's taxpayer identification number~~
 1-25 ~~system,~~] to each person [~~, other than a state employee,~~] who
 1-26 supplies property or services to the state for compensation or
 1-27 reimbursement.
 1-28 (b) The Texas Identification Number system shall be used by
 1-29 each state agency as the primary identification system for
 1-30 persons [~~, other than state employees,~~] who supply property or
 1-31 services to the agency for compensation or reimbursement. The
 1-32 agency may assign secondary numbers if the secondary numbering
 1-33 system does not unnecessarily create duplication of data bases,
 1-34 efforts, or costs.
 1-35 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
 1-36 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
 1-37 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
 1-38 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
 1-39 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
