9	Sec. 2060.001. DEFINITION. In this chapter, "state agency"
10	means a department, commission, board, office, council, authority,
11	or other agency in the executive, legislative, or judicial branch
12	of state government, including a university system or institution
13	of higher education as defined by Section 61.003, Education Code,
14	that is created by the constitution or a statute of this state.
15	Sec. 2060.002. CONSENT REQUIRED BEFORE SALE; RECORDS. (a)
16	Before a state agency may sell to a person information that alone or
17	in conjunction with other information identifies an individual, the
18	state agency must obtain the written consent of the individual.
19	(b) A state agency shall retain the consent of an individual
20	in the agency's records until the sales contract or agreement under
21	which the information is sold expires.
22	Sec. 2060.003. PROHIBITED SALES. A state agency may not:
23	(1) sell to a person any information that alone or in
24	conjunction with other information identifies an individual unless

- 1 the person agrees in writing not to resell the information;
- 2 (2) sell to a person who wishes to remain anonymous any
- 3 <u>information</u> that alone or in conjunction with other information
- 4 identifies an individual; or
- 5 (3) sell to a person any information that alone or in
- 6 conjunction with other information identifies an individual unless
- 7 the individual has provided written consent to the agency.
- 8 SECTION 2. Chapter 2060, Government Code, as added by this
- 9 Act, applies only to information sold by a state agency to another
- 10 person on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 11 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
