AN ACT

2 relating to a study of the feasibility and desirability of creating 3 and maintaining a coastal barrier system.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. (a) The legislature shall establish a joint 6 interim committee to continue to study the feasibility and 7 desirability of creating and maintaining a coastal barrier system 8 in this state that includes a series of gates and barriers to 9 prevent storm surge damage to gulf beaches or coastal ports, 10 industry, or property.

(b) The committee is composed of:

12 (1) the members of the standing committee of the13 senate that has primary jurisdiction over natural resources;

14 (2) the members of the standing committee of the house 15 of representatives that has primary jurisdiction over land and 16 resource management;

17 (3) two members of the senate appointed by the 18 lieutenant governor, each of whom represents a district in a county 19 that borders the Gulf of Mexico; and

20 (4) two members of the house of representatives 21 appointed by the speaker of the house of representatives, each of 22 whom represents a district in a county that borders the Gulf of 23 Mexico.

(c) The lieutenant governor and the speaker of the house of

representatives shall jointly designate a chair or, alternatively,
designate two co-chairs from among the committee membership.

3 (d) The committee may adopt rules necessary to carry out the4 committee's duties under this section.

5 (e) Not later than December 1, 2016, the committee shall 6 report to the governor and the legislature the findings of the study 7 and any recommendations developed by the committee under this 8 section.

SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
