AN ACT

2 relating to reimbursement for ambulance services provided to 3 persons enrolled in the Medicaid managed care program.

- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 533, Government Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 533.01316 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 533.01316. REIMBURSEMENT FOR AMBULANCE SERVICES. (a)
- 8 This section applies with respect to a recipient of medical
- 9 <u>assistance</u> who is an enrollee in a managed care plan under any
- 10 Medicaid managed care model or arrangement.
- 11 (b) The commission shall ensure that a person providing
- 12 <u>ambulance</u> services to a Medicaid managed care enrollee is
- 13 <u>reimbursed for emergency and nonemergency services provided to the</u>
- 14 enrollee at a rate that is equal to 100 percent of the allowable
- 15 rate for those services as determined under Section 32.028, Human
- 16 Resources Code, regardless of whether the services are provided by
- 17 a provider in the applicable Medicaid managed care plan's network
- 18 of providers.

- 19 SECTION 2. If before implementing any provision of this Act
- 20 a state agency determines that a waiver or authorization from a
- 21 federal agency is necessary for implementation of that provision,
- 22 the agency affected by the provision shall request the waiver or
- 23 authorization and may delay implementing that provision until the
- 24 waiver or authorization is granted.
