4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Section 41.001, Civil Practice and Remedies
6	Code, is amended by adding Subdivision (7-a) to read as follows:
7	(7-a) "Net worth" means the total assets of a person
8	minus the total liabilities of the person on a date determined
9	appropriate by the trial court.
10	SECTION 2. Chapter 41, Civil Practice and Remedies Code, is
11	amended by adding Section 41.0115 to read as follows:
12	Sec. 41.0115. DISCOVERY OF EVIDENCE OF NET WORTH FOR
13	EXEMPLARY DAMAGES CLAIM. (a) On the motion of a party and after
14	notice and a hearing, a trial court may authorize discovery of
15	evidence of a defendant's net worth if the court finds in a written
16	order that the claimant has demonstrated a substantial likelihood
17	of success on the merits of a claim for exemplary damages. Evidence
18	submitted by a party to the court in support of or in opposition to a
19	motion made under this subsection may be in the form of an affidavit
20	or a response to discovery.
21	(b) If a trial court authorizes discovery under Subsection
22	(a), the court's order may only authorize use of the least
23	burdensome method available to obtain the net worth evidence.
24	(c) When reviewing an order authorizing or denying

1	discovery of net worth evidence under this section, the reviewing
2	court may consider only the evidence submitted by the parties to the
3	trial court in support of or in opposition to the motion described
4	by Subsection (a).
5	SECTION 3. The change in law made by this Act applies only
6	to an action filed on or after the effective date of this Act.
7	SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
