- 6 SECTION 1. Subchapter Z, Chapter 44, Education Code, is
- 7 amended by adding Section 44.905 to read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 44.905. PROPERTY AND CASUALTY INSURANCE COSTS.
- 9 (a) Not later than December 1, 2016, the agency shall provide to
- 10 the governor, the lieutenant governor, and the members of the
- 11 <u>legislature a report containing:</u>
- 12 (1) the amount paid for property and casualty
- 13 insurance per student in average daily attendance by each school
- 14 <u>district and open-enrollment charter school; and</u>
- 15 (2) the statewide average amount paid by school
- 16 districts and open-enrollment charter schools for property and
- 17 casualty insurance per student in average daily attendance.
