## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Sections 201.354(d) and (g), Occupations Code, 6 are amended to read as follows:
- 7 (d) A person whose license has been expired for 90 days or
- 8 less may renew the license by paying to the board a renewal fee that
- 9 is equal to [the sum of] 1-1/2 times the annual renewal fee set by
- 10 the board under Section 201.153(a) [and the increase in that fee
- 11  $\frac{\text{required by Section 201.153(b)}}{\text{license has been}}$ ]. If a person's license has been
- 12 expired for more than 90 days but less than one year, the person may
- 13 renew the license by paying to the board a renewal fee that is equal

- 18 less may renew the license by paying to the board the required
