- 8 <u>ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICES</u>. (a) The service area of the Blinn <u>Junior</u>
- 9 College District includes the territory within:
- 10 (1) Washington, Burleson, Brazos, Madison, Grimes,
- 11 and Waller counties;
- 12 (2) the Mumford, Hearne, and Franklin independent
- 13 school districts located in Robertson County;
- 14 (3) Austin County, other than the territory within the
- 15 Wallis-Orchard Independent School District;
- 16 (4) the Milano and Gause independent school districts
- 17 located in Milam County;
- 18 (5) the part of the Richards Independent School
- 19 District that is located in Walker and Montgomery counties;
- 20 (6) the part of the Bryan Independent School District
- 21 that is located in Robertson County;
- 22 (7) Fayette County, other than the territory within
- 23 the Smithville Independent School District;
- 24 (8) Lee County, other than the territory within the

- 1 Elgin Independent School District; and
- 2 (9) the part of the Lexington Independent School
- 3 District that is located in Bastrop, Milam, and Williamson
- 4 counties.
- 5 (b) The administrative offices of the Blinn Junior College
- 6 District shall be maintained in Washington County.
- 7 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 8 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 9 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 10 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 11 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
