 1-20 AN ACT

1-21 relating to establishing an interstate voter registration  
 1-22 crosscheck program.

1-23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-24 SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 18, Election Code, is  
 1-25 amended by adding Section 18.062 to read as follows:

1-26 Sec. 18.062. INTERSTATE VOTER REGISTRATION CROSSCHECK  
 1-27 PROGRAM. (a) To maintain the statewide voter registration list  
 1-28 and to prevent duplication of registration in more than one state or  
 1-29 jurisdiction, the secretary of state shall cooperate with other  
 1-30 states and jurisdictions to develop systems to compare voters,  
 1-31 voter history, and voter registration lists to identify voters  
 1-32 whose addresses have changed.

1-33 (b) A system developed under this section must comply with  
 1-34 the National Voter Registration Act (52 U.S.C. Section 20501 et  
 1-35 seq.).

1-36 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives  
 1-37 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as  
 1-38 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this  
 1-39 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this  
 1-40 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
