7 If an incumbent local exchange company or cooperative is 8 ineligible for support under a plan established under Section 56.021(1) for services in an exchange, a plan established under 9 Section 56.021(1) may not provide 10 support to any telecommunications providers for services in that exchange, except 11 12 that an eligible telecommunications provider that is receiving 13 support under Section 56.021(1)(A) in that exchange shall continue to receive such support until the later of December 31, 2017, or the 14 second anniversary of [for a 24-month period following] the date 15 the incumbent local exchange provider or cooperative ceases 16 17 receiving support in that exchange. The support received by the eligible telecommunications provider during that [the 24-month] 18 period shall be at the same monthly per line support level in effect 19 for that exchange as of the date the incumbent local exchange 20

SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
