4	SECTION 1. Section 302.0031, Labor Code, is amended by
5	amending Subsection (b) and adding Subsection (g) to read as

7	(b) The commission shall establish and administer the
8	College Credit for Heroes [demonstration] program to identify,
9	develop, and support methods to maximize academic or workforce
10	education credit awarded by institutions of higher education to
11	veterans and military servicemembers for military experience,
12	education, and training obtained during military service in order
13	to expedite the entry of veterans and military servicemembers into
14	the workforce.
15	(g) Not later than November 1 of each year, the commission,
16	after consultation with the Texas Higher Education Coordinating
17	Board, shall report to the legislature and the governor on:
18	(1) the results of any grants awarded under this
19	section;
20	(2) the best practices for veterans and military
21	servicemembers to achieve maximum academic or workforce education
22	credit at institutions of higher education for military experience,

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(3) measures needed to facilitate the award of

education, and training obtained during military service;

- 4 (4) other related measures needed to facilitate the

- 7 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 8 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 9 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 10 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 11 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
