- 8 Sec. 55.009. LICENSE APPLICATION AND EXAMINATION FEES.
- 9 Notwithstanding any other law, a state agency that issues a license
- 10 shall waive the license application and examination fees paid to
- 11 the state for an applicant who is:
- 12 (1) a military service member or military veteran
- 13 whose military service, training, or education substantially meets
- 14 <u>all of the requirements for the license; or</u>
- 15 (2) a military service member, military veteran, or
- 16 military spouse who holds a current license issued by another
- 17 jurisdiction that has licensing requirements that are
- 18 substantially equivalent to the requirements for the license in
- 19 this state.
- 20 SECTION 2. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to
- 21 an application for an occupational license filed on or after the
- 22 effective date of this Act. An application for a license filed
- 23 before the effective date of this Act is governed by the law in
- 24 effect immediately before that date, and that law is continued in
