1-21 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
 1-22 AN ACT

1-23 relating to providing a translated copy of a student's
 1-24 individualized education program to parents unable to speak
 1-25 English.

1-26 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-27 SECTION 1. Section 29.005, Education Code, is amended by
 1-28 adding Subsection (d-1) to read as follows:

1-29 (d-1) In compliance with Subsection (d), the district shall
 1-30 provide the child's individualized education program in audiotape
 1-31 form if requested by the parent. Audiotaped copies shall include
 1-32 all components of the individualized education program required
 1-33 under state or federal law that are developed or revised by the
 1-34 committee.

1-35 SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2015-2016
 1-36 school year.

1-37 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
 1-38 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
 1-39 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
 1-40 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
 1-41 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
