1-19 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
 1-20 AN ACT

1-21 relating to the sale of distilled spirits to ultimate consumers by  
 1-22 the holder of a distiller's and rectifier's permit.

1-23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-24 SECTION 1. Section 14.05(c), Alcoholic Beverage Code, as  
 1-25 added by Chapter 106 (S.B. 905), Acts of the 83rd Legislature,  
 1-26 Regular Session, 2013, is amended to read as follows:

1-27 (c) The holder of a distiller's and rectifier's permit may  
 1-28 not under Subsection (b) sell more than two 750 milliliter bottles  
 1-29 or the equivalent of each distilled spirits product that has a label  
 1-30 that complies with the approval issued by the United States Alcohol  
 1-31 and Tobacco Tax and Trade Bureau [or the equivalent] to the same  
 1-32 consumer within a 30-day period. The total sales made by the holder  
 1-33 of a distiller's and rectifier's permit under Subsection (b) to the  
 1-34 same consumer may not exceed six 750 milliliter bottles or the  
 1-35 equivalent within a 30-day period.

1-36 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
